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#### Key Stage 2 results (provisional)

The table shows that percentage of children that achieved at least the expected standard. The children took KS2 SATs (tests) in Reading, Mathematics and Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling. The children were assessed by the teachers for writing. The number under the percentage is the Average Scaled Score of the test. This does apply to writing.

The 2018 – 2019 cohort was made up of a bulge provision with only 65 out 112 (58%) pupils on roll in the Autumn term of Year 2. Forty-seven pupils joined the school at various points during year 2 to year 6, with varying degrees of English and school experience.
