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Family-School Partnership Award

The Stonebridge School is taking part in a scheme being run in the London Boroughs Ealing, Harrow & Brent which will help us to think about how we work with families and support us to build stronger links between home and school.

The Family Partnership Model

The Family Partnership Model, developed in Ealing, aligns the different aspects of schools' work with parents and families under 5 key themes, with an overarching theme of monitoring and evaluation cutting across all areas:

Theme 1: Fostering effective family-school partnerships

Theme 2: Communicating and consulting effectively

Theme 3: Enabling parental engagement in learning

Theme 4: Empowering parents and carers to develop their own skills

Theme 5: Supporting successful transitions

The process supports schools to review their provision from the view point of stakeholder including teaching staff, support staff, governors and parents. We will be looking at lots of different areas including: the school environment; how we communicate and how we help you to support learning at home.
