## Free School Meals & Additional Funding for the School (Pupil Premium)

### Free school meals for KS1

All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 can get free schools meals whether the parents receive benefits or not.

If you receive benefits, it is still important that you to complete a free school meals application, even if you don't want your child to receive a free meal.

The school will get extra government funding for every child registered as eligible for a free school meal if their parents receive benefits. This funding is to support learning and is called the 'pupil premium'.

### How to apply

You can apply for free school meals online, if you think you are eligible.

Eligibility for free school meals will not be backdated, so please make sure you apply as soon as possible. If this is your first application, you will be asked to provide proof of child benefit. Use this link
