- * Learn number bonds to 20 **by heart**. For example; 10 + 10 = 20, 11 + 9 = 20
- Read and write numbers up to 100 in numerals.
- * Read and write numbers up to 100 in **numerals** and **words**.




Practise counting to 100 forwards and backwards, starting from any number.
